

Cambodia

Located entirely in the tropics and dominated by seasonal monsoons, Cambodia is ideally positioned as a supplier of high-quality rice. Made up of smallholder farmer collectives and capable of producing two crops per year, rice grown in Cambodia consistently receives international acclaim. The most popular varieties grown are white gold and jasmine.

Our project in Cambodia is a commitment to a sustainable source of organic products. We support 4,500 farmers, bringing their products from their farms to the world. We support local initiatives focused on gender equality, clean energy implementation, and climate impact.

OUR PRODUCTS

Long grain rice and jasmine rice are the primary products grown by our partners. Our rice is available in its raw form or can be parboiled or processed into derivatives such as flour or bran. We also source palm sugar and select varieties of spices, focusing on the unique flavor and authenticity of this region.





Uganda

Uganda's moderate tropical climate makes it one of the most fertile countries in Africa. Temperatures rarely venture more than a few degrees above or below 70 degrees Fahrenheit. Rainfall is plentiful, with a short dry season in December and January. With all of these attributes, there is no wonder as to why Uganda's certified organic land is growing rapidly.

DFI'S WORK IN UGANDA

DFI honors the strong tradition of cooperative farming in Uganda. We work with 35,000 smallholder farms, proudly promoting improved economic and social outcomes for nearly 350,000 people. Our farm partners have a guaranteed market where they can sell all their cash crops and receive training and assistance from dedicated field officers. Our local factory provides additional employment opportunities at fair wages and good working conditions.

OUR PRODUCTS

Sesame, chia, and bird's eye chilis are our main products. Birds' eye chilis from Africa are noted for their heat and are commonly processed into pepper extract. Chia, traditionally grown in Latin America, is a promising new crop that grows well in Uganda's fertile soil. Our organic sesame is ideal for paste, bakery, and crushing applications, with higher-than-average oil and protein values. We offer cleaning and sterilization locally with our FSSC 22000 certified production facility.


Grains




Pulses

Herbs & Spices


